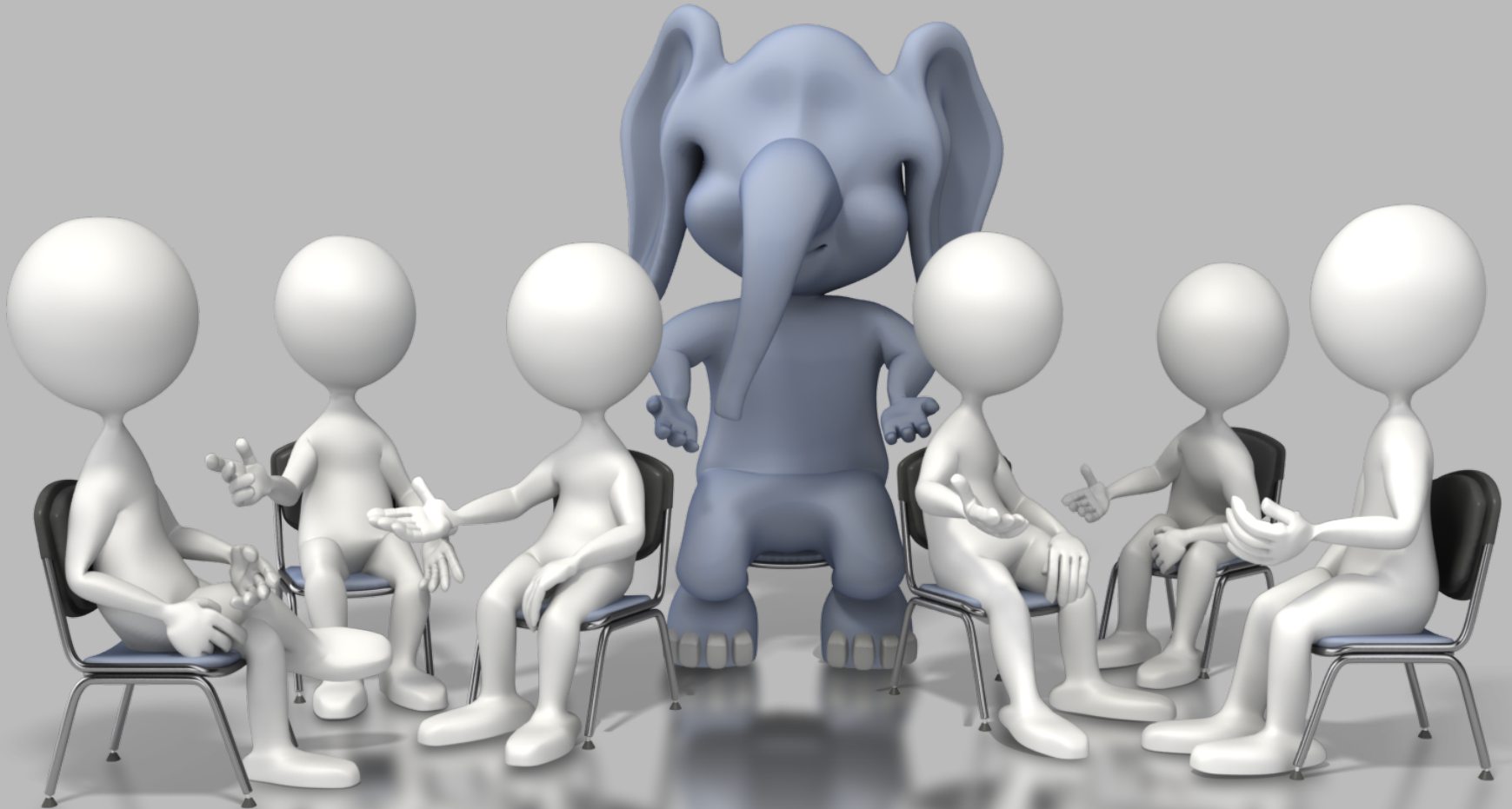
# ALL TIED UP!

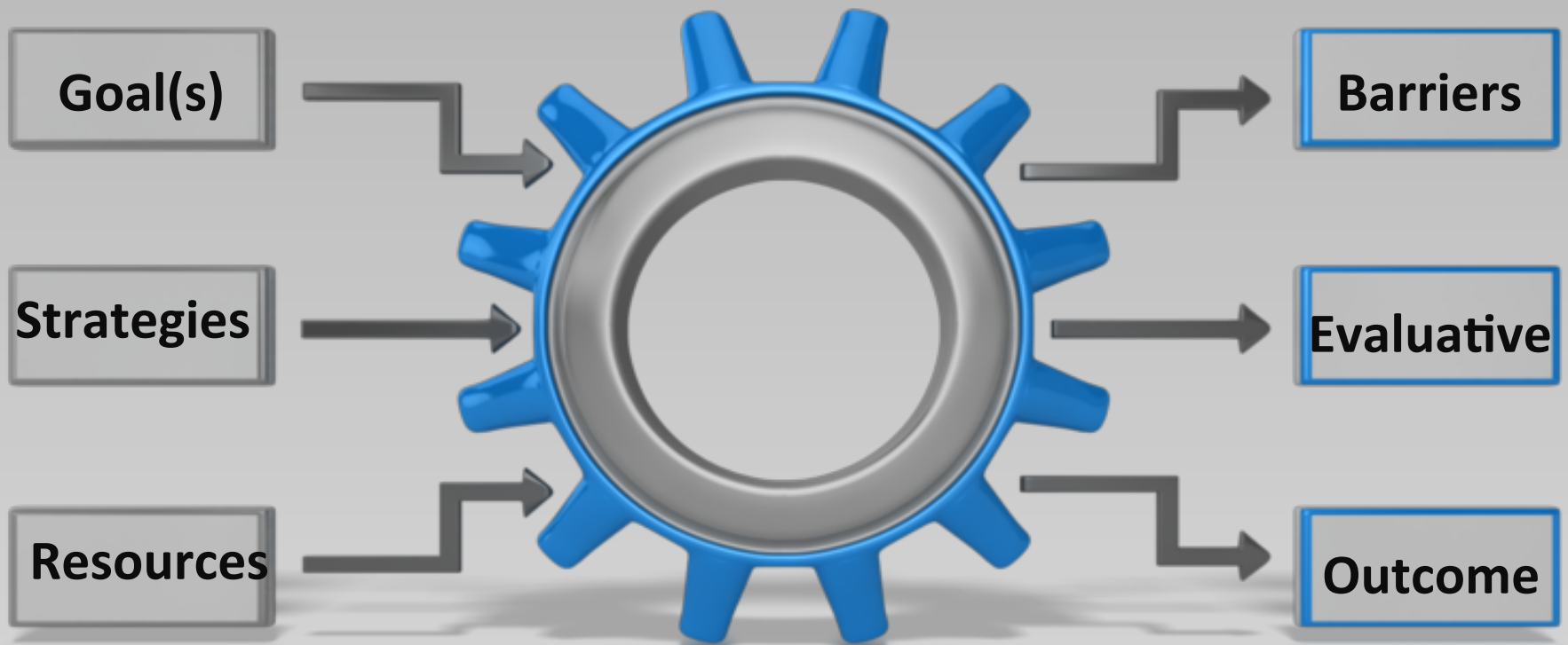

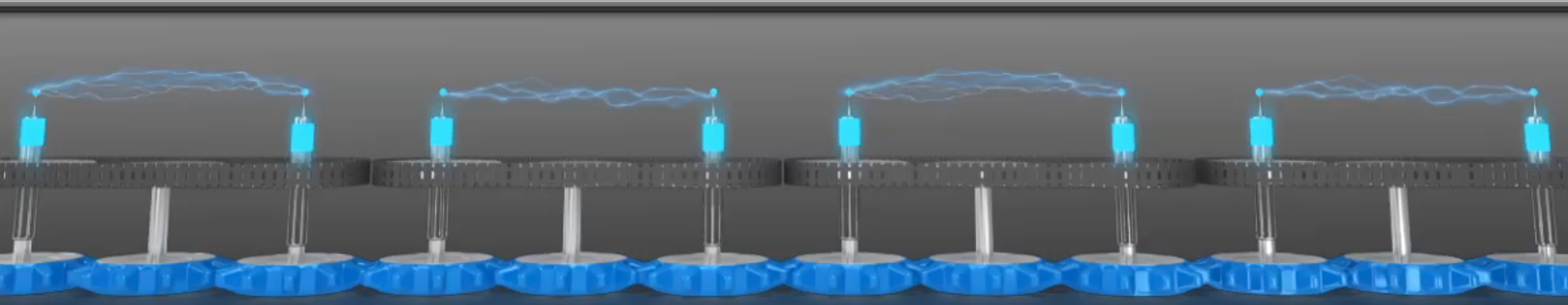

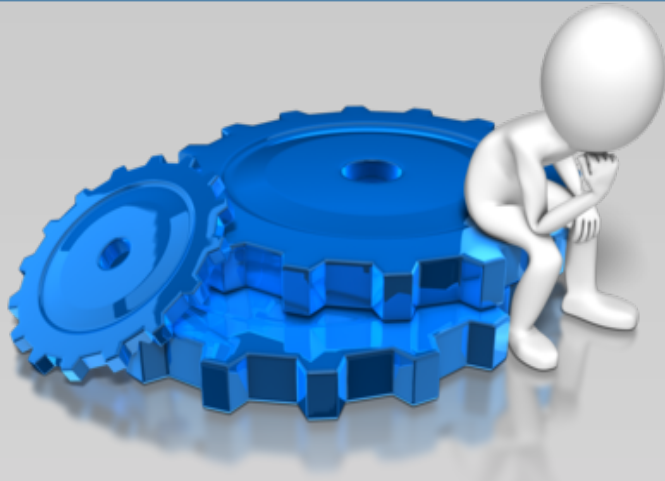
